☐ Build a waterproof emergency kit
Include bottled water, food, flashlight, radio, medications, and first aid supplies.
□ Create a family emergency plan
Map out evacuation routes and keep contact info accessible.
☐ Sign up for local flood alerts
Use provincial or municipal services to stay informed in real time.
□ Include pets in your plan
Have carriers, leashes, and food ready in case of evacuation.

☐ Practice your evacuation plan

Run through the steps with your household so everyone is prepared.
