

Pre-road trip checklist: Get your car and coverage ready



☐ **Verify policy details with your broker**

Make sure you understand how travelling (especially out of province or into the US) affects your insurance coverage.

☐ **Ensure your roadside assistance coverage is active**

Don't let flat tires or dead batteries ruin your trip—check your policy.

☐ **Check tire pressure, oil, and emergency supplies**

Make sure everything is in working order and ready to handle a long trip on the road.

☐ **Inspect the vehicle interior**

Confirm that the brakes, mirrors, and steering system are all functioning properly.

☐ **Test your lights**

Replace any burned-out bulbs and confirm that your headlights, brake lights, turn signals, taillights, and hazards are all working.

☐ **Top up vital fluids**

Check and refill windshield washer fluid, coolant, brake fluid, transmission fluid, and power steering fluid.

☐ **Save your claim and roadside support numbers**

Have contact info for your insurance provider and roadside assistance handy in case something goes wrong.

☐ **Plan your route**

Map out your route in advance to avoid getting lost and to identify rest stops or service stations.

☐ **Pack an emergency kit**

Include essentials like water, flashlights, batteries, a first aid kit, and basic tools in case of an emergency.
